Aware of the importance of maintaining a sustainable tourism development, and assuming the principles and objectives specifically adopted at the World Summit on Sustainable Development 2015, the COP 21 and the World Charter for Sustainable Tourism + 20, the Port of Mataró Consortium is committed to carrying out sustainable management of its activities, by adopting commitments aimed at preventing, eliminating or reducing the impact of our facilities and activities, both internally and externally, as well as optimising the sustainability of the establishment by improving its environmental performance.

In this sense, our organisation has adopted this Responsible Tourism Policy, by means of which it is committed to complying with the requirements established in the BIOSPHERE adhesion, which includes, among other aspects, the legal requirements that regulate the effects generated by tourism activity.

We are also committed to motivate and train our staff with training and awareness actions on the principles of Responsible Tourism, to promote good environmental practices in the environment and to participate in external activities, and to inform both internally and externally about the company's environmental actions and commitments.

In addition, our establishment expresses an express commitment to fight against sexual exploitation or any other form of commercial exploitation, in particular of children, adolescents, women and minors; and we are committed to taking measures of universal accessibility.

One of our main objectives is to improve sustainable management, taking on commitments to continuous improvement in all areas of sustainability: social, economic and environmental, as well as customer satisfaction. For this reason, projects for future extensions of facilities or activities will be subject to criteria of sustainability and efficiency in the use of resources.
